Information for Coach and Bus Operators

In the city centre within the Altstadttring (Old Town beltway) there are no parking facilities for tour buses. There are, however, some central arrival and departure zones to drop off and pick up passengers. For long-term parking, buses must use one of the parking facilities provided for this purpose. All of them are well connected to the public transportation network.

Please note: Munich has a **low emission zone**. Thus high-emission vehicles are no longer allowed to drive into the city **within the Mittlerer Ring** (middle beltway). Details can be found on the following link: www.environmental-badge.co.uk/en/environmental-badge.html

Important information: Due to construction works the arrival and departure zone **Thomas-Wimmer-Ring** will presumably be **closed** until the end of 2019. The square in front of the National Theater, **Max-Joseph-Platz**, has been **closed** for travel coaches and can no longer be used to drop off and pick up passengers.
