They can be used by travelers as well as all other persons.



Free tests for everyone @ MAC Forum (public area)

General information about this test option:

Incoming travellers and also other persons (citizen testing) who wish to be tested for possible infection with the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus can do so free of charge at the Corona Test Center. The Corona Test Center is located in the Forum of the Munich Airport Center (MAC) on Level 04 and is open daily from 6 a.m. to midnight.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Travelers who require proof of testing for their trip abroad, including their ID card number, for example, should contact one of the private test centers [see page 5+]

Free antigen rapid test @ Wirtsgarten Airbräu (public area)

General information about this test option:

Citizens and passengers can now also be tested free of charge via the subsidiary Allresto. The result of the POC antigen rapid test is usually issued within 15 to 30 minutes after sample collection. The Test Center is located at the Wirtsgarten of the Airbräu in the München Airport Center (MAC) on level 04 and is open daily from 8:30 am to 4 pm.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Travelers who require proof of testing for their trip abroad, including their ID card number, for example, should contact one of the private test centers [see page 5+]

Free tests for arriving passengers (non-public area)

General information about this test option:

Returning travelers (with a final destination in Germany), still have access to a testing center in the non-public area in Terminal 2 (near the baggage carousels).

The service is available between 5 a.m. - 7 p.m.

The test is performed as a throat swab

Tests for International Transfer Passengers at Terminal 2 (non-public area)

General information about this test option:

Two Covid-19 test stations are available in Terminal 2 for transferring passengers.

- Transfer area Schengen: opposite gate G32
- Transfer area Non Schengen: at gate H17

The following internationally recognized testing options are offered there:

- SARS-CoV2-RT PCR (throat swab, result usually after 3 to 4 hours)
- PCR-Express: Test result usually within 60 to 120 minutes. This test is currently only offered from 6 am to 12:30 pm and can be booked during this period.
- SARS-CoV2- Antigen-Rapid (throat swab, result after usually 1 to 2 hours)
- PCR test for Japan entry: incl. certificate according to Japanese government. Result within 3-6 hours.

The service is available between 5 a.m. - 7 p.m.





Tests for International Transfer Passengers at Terminal 2 (non-public area)

Costs?

- SARS-CoV2-RT PCR test for 128,- Euro (throat swab, result usually after 3 to 4 hours)
- PCR-Express: 178€ (incl. VAT)
- SARS-CoV2- Antigen-Rapid Test for 45,- Euro (throat swab, result after usually 1 to 2 hours)
- PCR test for Japan entry: 128€

Payment for the test is exclusively cashless via the test registration website. Passengers can obtain more information from the on-site test center.





Test at the "Test & Fly" Center at Terminal 2 (public area)

General information about this test option:

The "Test & Fly" Center offers a testing with fastest possible result determination. The Center is open daily from 5 am to 8 pm and is located at Terminal 2, level 04

4 test options are available:

- 1. SARS-CoV-2 RT-PCR Test*: Test result usually within 3 to 6 hours. Sampling: throat swab. Detection of the following virus variants possible: B.1.1.7 (origin in England), B.1.351 (origin in South Africa), P.1 (origin in Brazil). (Virus sequencing is performed from all PCR-positive SARS-CoV-2 samples. The determined sequences are made available to the Robert Koch Institute (RKI)).
- 2. PCR-Express: Test result usually within 60 to 120 minutes. This test is currently only offered from 6 am to 12:30 pm and can be booked during this period.
- 3. SARS-CoV-2 Rapid Antigen Test*: Test result usually within 30 to 60 minutes. Sampling: throat swab.
- 4. PCR test for Japan entry: incl. certificate according to Japanese government. Result within 3-6 hours.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> The tests, which are subject to a charge, are primarily aimed at departing passengers at Munich Airport. Non-travelers, rail travelers or car travelers can also have a test done here.

How to get the results?

Within three to six hours, a push message is sent to their mobile phone announcing that the results are ready. The full medical report is also sent by email in German and English. A positive test result will be reported to the public health department.

According to §7 (1) of the German Infection Protection Act (IfSG) the laboratory is obliged to report a positive test result to the public health department

Tests by MediCare / Test directly at the doctor (public area)

General information about this test option:

MediCare, a subsidiary of Flughafen München GmbH, offer the following all-day test options at the airport's medical center (Emergency Outpatient Clinic Terminal 1, Module E, Level 03):

- PCR test for a fee of 184.44 euros*
- Rapid antigen tests [nasal swab, result in 30 minutes]: from 73.27 euros*
- Antibody IgG and IgM rapid tests (venous blood draw, result in 20 minutes) from 66,64 Euro*
- Fit to Fly tests: from 67,92 Euro*

Good to know:

All tests are performed by medical doctors. All tests and examinations are confirmed by a medical certificate (German/English). **Attention:** Tests are performed **only** on persons **without** Covid-19 symptoms, or without contact with a person who may have contracted Covid-19.

How to get the results?

Within 24 hours at the latest, travelers receive their findings by e-mail in German and English. A positive test result must be reported to the health department in accordance with regulatory requirements

By undergoing the PCR test, passenger also get a valid test certificate for Japan.

CENTOGENE: PCR, antigen tests and Japan tests (public area)

General information about this test option:

CENTOGENE offers the following test options daily from 5 am to 10 pm (Terminal 1, direction T1 Departure C/D, Level 3):

- Antigen rapid test (Express-1): Results within 30 minutes (29€, only available until 9 p.m.)
- PCR rapid test [Premium-1]: Results within 60 minutes [139 euros, appointment booking required at corona.centogene.com]
- PCR-Test (Premium-24): Results within 24 hours [69€]
- PCR test for Japan entry: Result within 24 hours [89€ incl. certificate according to Japanese government]

Good to know:

- It is recommended to register in advance
- payment is made in advance online by credit card or PayPal via the company's Corona Test Portal or contactlessly by debit or credit card on site

<u>Attention:</u> Only persons who do not have any symptoms can be tested in order to protect the health of the employees and the persons who are tested in the test center. Please wear a medical mask (so-called surgical masks or also masks of the standards KN95/N95 or FFP2) in the test centers.
