You could almost imagine yourself in the courtyard of a Moorish caliph's palace.



KING SUITE

STANDARD ROOMS

'La comelona' means opulent meal - and there are plenty of those in Andalusia. The dishes are a mixture of various cultural influences, such as the legacy of Antiquity, the Moorish occupation and the overseas trade.

Before the main course, diners often eat tapas. These are small appetisers, often spicy and with plenty of garlic. In rural areas they like to serve grilled Butifarra. In addition, meat dishes of Iberico or Bellota pork are widespread, as well as aubergines and peppers alongside vegetables and beans. On the coast, fish dishes are of course the most common, and are often fried: from mussels to sepia to prawns, all kinds of delicacies are served here. In the summer, light cuisine dominates, for example, the popular cold vegetable soup Gazpacho. Andalusia is known internationally for its paella varieties, its air-dried Iberico ham, goat and sheep's cheese, and its sherry.



Up to four noblemen can be accommodated in a themed suite. These are named after the American explorer Christopher Columbus and the Spanish Cardinal Mendoza. All themed suites have balconies and minibars. The loving decoration gives the chambers a noble, courtly touch.

PRESIDENTIAL SUITES

RESTAURANT CASTILLO:

Juicy meat is prepared on the grill according to an old gaucho recipe.
Mediterranean accompaniments and homemade specialties complete the culinary spectrum.

BAR BUENA VISTA CLUB: Right at the top, on the ninth floor, is the panorama bar. Old wooden beams on the ceiling, a knight's armour, small wooden horses, a Spanish monk figure and various coats of arms take you into a historicmedieval ambience. In the Medieval Ages – between the 6th and 15th centuries – there was a great deal of difference between what ordinary people ate and what was served up for dinner in a castle. For the nobles had the right to hunt, therefore they were served plenty of meat such as wild boar, venison, rabbit or pheasant. Similarly, fishing for freshwater fish was reserved for the nobility. There were also 'higher' – harvested from the tree – fruits such as pears, apples, cherries and figs.


In that era, sweet and salty foods were often eaten together, such as meat dishes with braised apples or casseroles made with meat combined with herbs and dates. At large banquets, of course, sociability also played a key role. The large round table was host to eating, drinking, singing and hailing the entertainment of jugglers.


Whether the knights' armours still fit perfectly after these extensive bouts is, however, not known. But thankfully you don't have to worry about that anymore - you can feast as much as your heart desires in our buffet restaurant. El Cid and King Arthur would have been jealous if they had seen the long, massive wooden tables in the Castillo. Simply enjoy with all your senses!


STANDARD ROOMS

RESTAURANT BEER CELLAR:

It was particularly hard to be a monk or nun during Lent, when they weren't allowed to eat from sunrise to sunset. However, rest assured that no one will have to go hungry at the vaulted monastery cellar, a full-service restaurant with international cuisine.

The Portuguese love home cooking: the food should be down-to-earth and nutritious, but just as interestingly flavoured, for example with garlic, coriander, nutmeg, oregano, thyme, laurel or the small red chilli pepper Piri-Piri.

The national dish of Portugal is the Bacalhau, a salted and dried cod, for which there are innumerable methods of preparation. It has been popular since the time of the great seafarers of the 15th and 16th centuries, when explorers would take the preserved fish with them on their travels. Other types of fish and seafood feature strongly in Portuguese cuisine, such as shrimp, marlin, scallops and tuna. However, meat lovers will also get their money's worth with beef and lamb dishes and dishes from Iberico pork and fresh poultry.

And what is there for dessert? Delicious home-made sweat treats, from almond cake to 'pudim caseiro', an egg pudding with caramel sauce, or selected Spanish and Portuguese cheese specialties.

In our buffet restaurant Sala Santa Isabel you can taste everything that appeals to you. The feast is accompanied by fresh 'Vinho Verde' or other fine wines from our richly filled wine cellar. Finally, try our home-made herbal liqueur 'Apotheke' as a digestive. Bom apetite!




